THE

WHITE SWAN And The TITANIC Connection

The White Swan Hotel in Alnwick is inextricably linked to the disaster of 1912. The Titanic's sister ship, the RMS Olympic, was launched in 1911, a year before its sister's tragic maiden voyage. Despite being converted to oil-fired engines in 1919-1920, it became uneconomical in comparison to the new and luxurious Queen Mary and Queen Elizabeth, and was finally retired in 1935 and scrapped in 1937.

Before it was dismantled completely, many of the fittings and artworks were auctioned. The then-owner of The White Swan, Algenon Smart (who had been a frequent passenger on the liner), successfully bid for the panelling to the Olympic's first class lounge, the staircase and the revolving doors to the liner's restaurant, and transported them to the hotel, reconstructing them in all its splendour.

The magnificent Olympic Suite, which can cater for up to 120 diners, now shows off the original panelling, mirrors, ceiling and stained glass windows from a time when ships were truly magnificent. An eccentric idea perhaps, but one that has made The White Swan very special.
